## Special Summer Programs

### Orff Mini Camp (ages 5-9)

This fun-filled 3-week course features daily Orff classes and is supplemented with weekly yoga classes, movement or recorder class, and introduction to various musical instruments. Daily craft time will be spent working on props and staging for the culminating activity: a performance showcasing the songs, movements, accompaniments and crafts on which they've worked during the 3 weeks. A snack and beverage will be provided daily.

### KMA Idol (ages 10-18)

Wish you could be the next *American Idol*? Well, why not start by being the next KMA Idol? The class consists not only of watching and discussing clips of *American Idol*, but also working on proper vocal technique (use of head voice, chest voice, vibrato, breath support, intonation), song selection, microphone technique, stage presence, branding (creating your image), and movement. The course culminates in performing a song for "KMA judges." (Don't worry- no one is named Simon! Everyone is a winner!)

### Guitar Boot Camp

Take your playing to the next level! Calisthenics for the guitarist, we will focus on technique, technique, technique! Left and right hand techniques covered include ascending and descending slurs, barring, arpeggios, and rasqueado. Handouts, a swag bag, a practice planner and Scott Tennant's book "Pumping Nylon" included in tuition. This four week course is not for the faint of heart!

### Introduction to Flute

Interested in joining your school's band this fall? This class is for you! Get a jump on the school year by learning the parts of the flute, how to properly assemble and care for your instrument, basic hand positions, good posture, and how to start making a sound.

### Flute Camp

Expand your technique and knowledge of the flute. Course time is divided between technique and repertoire. Fundamental skills including breathing, tone, articulation, fingering, and phrasing are addressed in this five day workshop through group participation of basic exercises (complete with handouts and suggestions on how to incorporate them into your own practice!). An overview of repertoire, by era, will include listening to, and discussing, important solo, chamber and orchestral works featuring the flute. This will also include "hands-on" instruction about various performance practices including proper execution of baroque trills, easy intro to extended techniques for modern music, etc.

### Vocal/Theatrical Audition Workshop

This workshop is intended for students who wish to prepare for the various aspects of a vocal or theatrical audition. Through a combination of instruction, discussion, and hands-on exercises, students will acquire a wealth of information to draw upon in preparation for the audition process including basic audition requirements, etiquette, attire, selection of audition material, and much, much more!

### American Fiddle: An Introduction

An introduction to traditional American fiddle tunes, classes will consist of listening to, and learning fiddle tunes by ear. Stylistic embellishments and counter-melodies will be covered, as well. Additionally, students are encouraged to learn tunes to teach the class. Listening is highly emphasized. Videos demonstrating various fiddle techniques will be shown, and students will write their own tune at the end of the term! A performance of the tunes caps off the 5-week course.

### Introduction to Irish Fiddle

Sure to have your toes tappin'! An introduction to Irish regional fiddling styles and forms such as jigs, reels, rounds, songs, etc., classes will consist of listening to, and learning tunes. Listening is highly emphasized and tunes will be learned exclusively by ear. Stylistic embellishments and counter-melodies will also be addressed. This 5-week course culminates in a performance.

Pre-requisites: Can play all notes in first position, 6 months of previous classical study.

Dream of playing in a string quartet? Here is a great place to start! Playing in a small ensemble is a fantastic opportunity to sharpen your skills as a musician and have fun at the same time!
