



## SECRETS FOR SUCCESS!

### PRACTICING

- Students should have a regular, non-interrupted practice schedule. Consult your teacher to as the length of daily practice and specific materials to practice (e.g. technical exercises, new pieces, polishing recently learned pieces, etc.).
- Suzuki students should review old pieces, as well as listen to the Suzuki CD that corresponds to their current book. Please note: it is the parent's responsibility to play the CD. *Listening and review are more important than the new!*
- All students are encouraged to listen to professional recordings and attend concerts.

Please note that by teacher's recommendation, a student who is repeatedly unprepared for lessons, may be placed on probation for one quarter. Lessons may be terminated if improvement is not seen by the end of the probationary period.

### AT THE LESSON

- The most successful students attend lessons and classes regularly.
- Suzuki parents are expected to take copious notes in both the private lesson and group class. Please come prepared with a notebook and pen.
- All students should come to lessons with clean hands and nails.
- All students should come prepared with all necessary materials (e.g. foot rest, music, rosin, etc.).
